

BAT-TACULAR HALLOWEEN INVITE

MATERIALS NEEDED:

A7 Folded Cards Chartreuse · Bat Rubber Stamp ·
For, Date, Time, Place Rubber Stamp · Graphite Black
Brilliance Pigment Ink Pad · 8 1/2" x 11" Black Text
Weight Paper · Red Adhesive Crystals · 4" Round
Labels Eco-White · 1/4" Super Tacky Tape ·
Scissors · Bonefolder · Ruler · Pencil

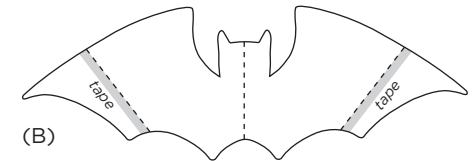
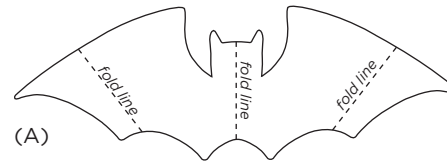
INSTRUCTIONS:

Using Graphite Black ink pad, stamp bat images onto inside of card. (Tip: Have fun with them by stamping them every which way... even up-side-down!)

Trace and cut out bat shape from black text weight paper using template below.

Fold bat where indicated (A). Confirm placement of bat inside card by holding in place and opening and closing card several times. When satisfied, adhere super tacky tape as shown (B), stick one side of bat into place with all parts folded and then fold card closed on top of folded bat, adhering second side of bat to card.

Create eyes by placing adhesive crystals on big bat's face. Open card and stamp For, Date, Time, Place below bat on card right panel. Fill in party details. For the card front, print "You're invited to..." onto a 4" round Eco-White printable label that will look like a moon. Adhere in place and stamp one bat next to moon sticker.
