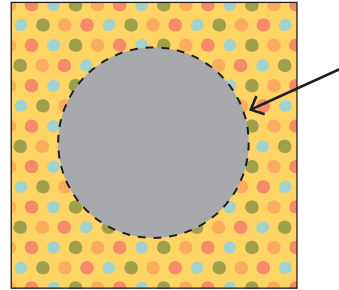


# ✂ POLKA DOT PAPER PARASOLS

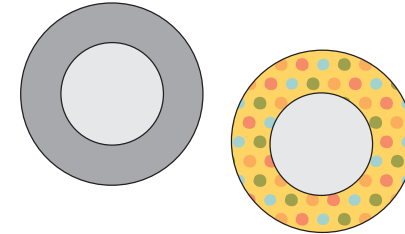

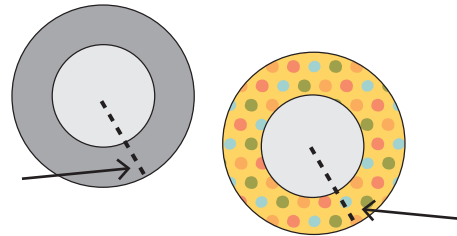
A. CUT OUT CIRCLE USING STICKER AS A GUIDE.



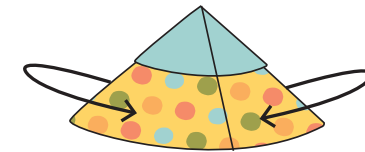
B. ADHERE SMALLER CIRCLE TO EITHER SIDE OF LARGER CIRCLE.



C. CUT A STRAIGHT LINE UP TO THE CENTER OF THE CIRCLE.



D. OVERLAP TO CREATE A CONE SHAPE AND ADHERE.



## MATERIALS NEEDED:

Red & White Paper Straws • Polka Dots Origami Paper Pack • 4" Round Labels in various colors • Text Weight paper in various colors • 2 1/4" Circle Hole Punch  
Glue Stick • Large Glue Dots • Scissors

## INSTRUCTIONS:

Create bottom layer of parasol by adhering a 4" round label in the color of your choice to a sheet of polka dots paper. Using the edge of the label as a guide, cut off the excess paper with scissors (A). Punch out a circle from a contrasting color of text weight paper using the 2 1/4" hole punch. Choose which side you would like to be the top side of your parasol and use glue stick to adhere the smaller circle on top of the larger one (B). Use scissors to cut a straight line halfway through the layered circles (C). Create a cone shape by overlapping the circle at the cut line and adhere in place using glue stick (D). Secure to straw with a large glue dot on the underside of the parasol.
